### **ASTA Board Unanimously Approves All Agenda Items**

The Board of Directors for the Arkansas Science & Technology Authority (ASTA) met today at 1:30 p.m. by telephone for its scheduled July meeting, which resulted in the unanimous approval or confirmation of all agenda items.

Board action included the approval of two Seed Capital Investment Program (SCIP) investments. The two Arkansas-based companies to receive ASTA investment funds are Law Office Information Systems (LOIS) of Fort Smith and Comfort Diagnostics and Solutions of Sherwood.
